

VILHJALMUR T. BJARNAR, curator of the Fiske Icelandic Collection at Cornell University, died on August 30.

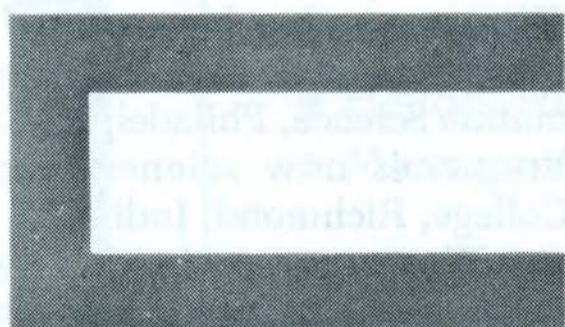
