Marilyn J. Sharrow has retired from the University of California (UC)-Davis after serving for 24 years as university librarian. She first worked at the Detroit Public Library and then joined the Syracuse University Libraries, where she headed the Fine Arts Department. She was later director of the Roseville Public Library in Michigan, then

returned to higher education, working at the University of Washington. Sharrow became director of libraries at the University of Manitoba and the chief librarian at the University of Toronto before joining UC-Davis. Altogether, she worked as a librarian for 41 years, compiling a long resume of service on committees and boards around the United States and Canada, publishing articles and giving presentations and speeches, including testifying once on Capitol Hill on behalf of the Library of Congress, and receiving several awards and grants, including a British Council Grant. She served as both the president of the Association of Research Libraries and as president of the Canadian Association of Research Libraries. Sharrow is now university librarian emerita.
