Accepted into Elsevier's Scopus database in early 2023 is a historic record for us.

At the same time, we have challenges. As review requirements are constantly improving, steps are being taken to extend the review period for submitted articles, and in some cases, the articles under review will be moved to the next issue.

Nine articles were received on this issue, one did not meet the requirements, one had copyright issues, and three of them were slow in the revision-revision process. Therefore, the acceptance rate dropped to 40%. Despite these challenges, we hope that the journal will overcome these difficult times to improve its quality.

In this journal issue, research on geology, geochemistry, geochronology, mineralogy, and geophysics has been published, adding new information and knowledge to Mongolian geological research.

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
